Students in grade 4 through adult who are reading or spelling below grade level

Lesson Implementation – Intensity and Duration

Instruction in a 1:1 setting occurs 2-5 times per week for 60-90 minutes.

When in a small group of 3-6 students, instruction should take place 3 times a week for 90 minutes, or 5 times a week for 45-90 minutes.

Reading classes of 7-15 students should receive instruction five times per week for 90 minutes.

Proper student placement is the most important factor for successful group instruction.

Teacher Support and Professional Development

Training in the Wilson Reading System is recommended so that the program is properly implemented in this setting.

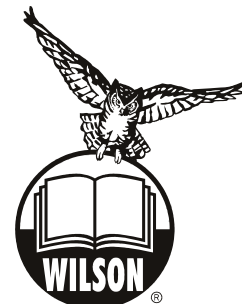
Teachers begin with a 3-day Intervention Workshop.

Teachers then enroll in Wilson Academy, a web-based support network for those using the Wilson Reading System. Enrollment in Academy / BASIC provides an opportunity to participate in an online community with others sharing the same goal of helping students become fluent, independent readers.

A more in-depth course, offered with Academy / INTERVENTION membership, is designed to guide participants in the specific WRS instructional methods and concepts taught at each substep. Participants have access to 90 hours of interactive online seminar instruction in Steps 1-6 of the Wilson Reading System.

Implementation visits for coaching and feedback can be provided as needed and with trainer availability.
